HOURS OF OPERATION *(Weather permitting)*

Monday - Friday • 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. or dusk during months when days are shorter
(June 15th to Labor Day. Off season months vary.)

Saturday & Sunday • 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. or dusk during months when days are shorter.
(All year-round. Closed Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.)

Reservations are required. All customers must arrive one half hour early prior to reserved time to sign paperwork and be present for a required demonstration on how to ride. Late arrivals will lose their reserved time and will not be able to participate but may reschedule for another ride provided there are times available. It would be appreciated if you can please give us a courtesy call of at least four hours notice if you have to cancel.

RATES AND TIMES *(Effective March 24, 2010)*

Trail Rides (Children must be 8 years old to go on a trail ride)

Price: \$40 per person. Times: Every hour on the hour. First ride is at 10 a.m., last ride is at 4 p.m.

Pony Rides

Price: \$3.00 for one time around the corral. If it rains, rides are given in the indoor arena.

Reservations for pony rides are not required. Pony rides are given when the trail horses have left the corral.

Horse-drawn Carriage Rides (Saturday evening and Sunday only)

Carriage holds 4 adults or 2 adults and 3 small children. There is a weight limit of approx. 750 lbs.

Boarding

\$380 per month per horse (must have current cogins papers)

(Does not include vet bills, shots, worming, etc. Supplements, grain other than what we supply and farrier services not included.)

Overnight Boarding

\$20.00 per day per horse (Must bring own grain, hay and current cogins papers.)

Pony Parties

\$100 per hour per pony

English and Western Style and Basic: \$60.00 for 1 hour • \$40.00 for 30 minutes

Weather conditions: We go out on trail rides if it is raining or snowing lightly, which will be determined by Country Carriage Services, Inc. We will not go out in heavy rain, thunder and lightning storms and poor trail conditions.

During poor weather conditions, pony rides can be given in the indoor arena.

Proper attire: Long pants, jeans and sneakers or shoes with a small flat heel are acceptable.

Sandals, flip flops or any open-toed shoes are not acceptable.
